Forklift Training Tips

It is essential that all workplaces making use of forklifts have the following checklist or one equivalent on the premises. If all of the safety rules are being followed, each of these questions must be answered with a "yes". A "no" to any question indicates a procedural flaw that could cause damage to machine, accident or injury.

- 1) Is the pedestrian traffic separated from the forklift working area?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to travel areas of the forklift restricted by barriers?
- 3) The pedestrian walkways well-marked?
- 4) A sign is clearly visible stating a "forklift in operation"?
- 5) There are mirrors provided at blind spots for pedestrians and operators?
- 6) Alterations or changes to the daily forklift schedule has been communicated to workers?
- 7) Are forklift tires suitable for utilization on all operating surfaces?
- 8) Is the seatbelt being utilized?
- 9) The seat of the forklift is in good condition?
- 10) Is a regular forklift maintenance schedule adhered to?
- 11) Is a yearly forklift inspection and certification carried out?
- 12) Is the kind of forklift appropriate for the tasks?
- 13) Is there a load chart that is readable on the forklift?
- 14) Do all operators know how to read the load chart?
- 15) The chart lists the safe lifting capacity for all attachments and their uses?
- 16) Are the warning devices on the forklift working properly?
- 17) The speed operating control device is secured right?
- 18) The lift truck overhead cage is fitted properly?
- 19) Have all forklift operators obtained certification?
- 20) Are warning signs and speed limits being observed?
- 21) Are forklift operators up to date on training for all kinds of forklifts being used?
- 22) Do operators understand their responsibilities to report any machine damage and lift truck incidents?
- 23) Is the pre-test checklist reviewed on a daily basis prior to the machine being utilized?
