The load is projected out from the front of the machinery so it is visible to the forklift operator. This particular type of forklift truck must just be utilized on prepared surface or on level, stable ground.

Forklift drivers are required to receive training that would allow them to better know the proper or right method across the forklift arms. The trainee will learn to properly lower and raise the load vertically and how to tilt the mast of the lift truck, moving the mast between 5 and 15 degrees both forwards and backwards. Trainees will be taught the RTITB standards required for operating the forklift safely. Individuals training will likewise know the types of attachments for the arms of the forklift.

Types of Counterbalance Forklifts:

Walkie Pallet Trucks
